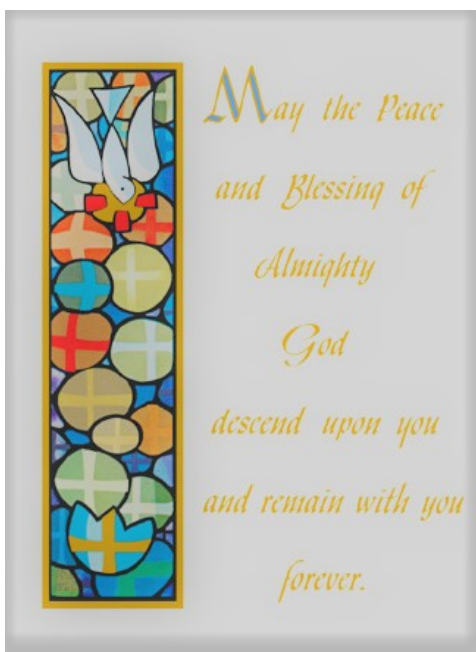
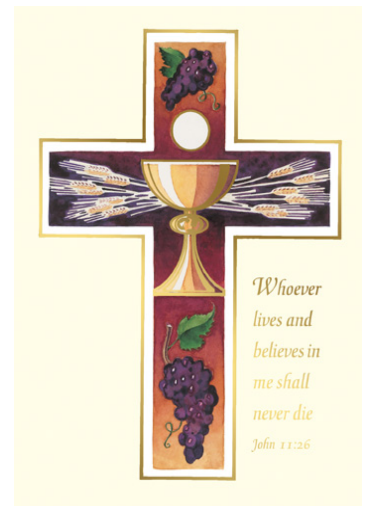


Help support a missionary priest by having Masses said for Loved Ones
